After discussion initiated by Diana Espino on general matters related to the actions of the MCSHOA Board,

she indicated she would "file a grievance" regarding the Board's actions.

The Board then turned to the business at hand: witnessing the counting of ballots for the proposed Special

Assessment of \$100 per cabin to defray legal costs for rewrite of the MCSHOA By Laws and CC&Rs to bring

them in conformity with current state codes governing the actions of HOAs.

Mark indicated the number of valid ballots received (82) and indicated that this exceeds the quorum of 50% of

eligible voters. (A total of 119 cabin owners are eligible to vote.) Black asked if Board members wanted to

extend the election. Steadman moved and Carpenter seconded that we not extend the voting period given the

robust turnout and number of ballots that exceed the quorum. Passed unanimously.

The supervisor of elections for the Special Assessment is Business Connections. The ballots were opened at

the offices of Business Connections, 332 Pine St, Red Bluff, CA and counted by Sheryl McGinnis and Joy

Graham, both of whom are notary publics.

The Board witnessed the opening and counting of the ballots.

The final tally of votes was: Yes: 73 No: 9

Carpenter moved, Steadman seconded, to accept the results, pending their certification as legitimate by

Business Connections. Black indicated that he will be in contact with Board members regarding our next

meeting near the end of April.
